



Concerns: open procedure for delivery of extended SWIR (InGaAs) camera.

Question 1.

Answer:

The Contracting Entity party agrees to change the Time of performing the Contract to a maximum of 16 weeks from the date of signing the agreement

I. **Chapter V. Time of performing the Contract:**

After changing paragraph 1 in Chapter XI of the ToR shall read as follows:

The Contract shall be performed at the latest up to **16 weeks** from the date of signing the agreement

II. **Chapter XI. Bid validity period:**

After changing paragraph 1 in Chapter XI of the ToR shall read as follows:

1. The Contractor shall be bound by the bid until the **26.11.2022**

III. **Chapter XIII. Manner and date of placing and opening the bids:**

After changing paragraph 1 and 2 in Chapter XIII of the ToR shall read as follows:
